



Becoming a Holocaust & Genocide Educator Summer 2025 Study Abroad

Description: This course prepares educators to understand and teach the difficult and complex topics of the Holocaust and genocide. Participants gain access to vetted standards-based content and pedagogical resources that frame the study of genocide using the Holocaust as a powerful case study. Principles and foundations in both economic and Holocaust education are integrated. In economics, students draw from witness testimonies to learn how political philosophies shape economic policies, priorities, and human rights. In Holocaust education, students apply high-leverage practices in teaching in the grade 5-12 classroom about genocide and the Holocaust.

- **Berlin-** Tour of Jewish Museum & Old Quarter; Sachsenhausen Museum & Memorial, Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe, Unter den Linden, Reichstag, Brandenburg Gate, Kurfürstendamm, Remains of the Berlin Wall

➤ **Poland**

- **Warsaw-** Ghetto Monument & Walking Tour, POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews
- **Lodz-** Jewish Ghetto, Piotrkowska Street, Jewish Cemetery, Grand Poznanski Palace
- **Lublin-** Madajnek, Old Town, Parish House Orphanage, Lublin Castle
- **Krakow-** Auschwitz, Birkenau, Oscar Schindler Factory, Wawel Castle, Old Town, Jewish Quarter, Galacia Jewish Museum, Jagiellonian University

Total Cost: 13 days for approximately \$3,500 not including airfare and tuition. Costs include in-country transportation, lodging (shared accommodations), all breakfasts and 7/11 dinners, tour and entrance fees to attractions, on-site faculty supervision, and tips and gratuities for guides and drivers.
